VIRTUAL TRAIL-O

Due to the circumstances that COVID19 is causing and following the example of other colleagues, we present a new virtual TRAIL-O, which will be held on April 18 and 19, in TEMP-O mode through the streets of Cádiz (South Spain).

COMPETITION SCHEDULES

The scheduled program for the test is as follows

<u>Thursday, April 16th:</u>	11:59 p.m. - Registration closes
<u>Friday, April 17th:</u>	Sending of last instructions and link for the competition.
<u>Saturday, April 18th:</u>	STAGE 1: 08h00 - Activation of the competition form for stage 1. 19h00 - Closing of the competition form for stage 1. 19h30 - Publication of results and solutions of stage 1.
<u>Sunday, April 19th:</u>	STAGE 2: 08h00 - Activation of the competition form for stage 2. 19h00 - Closing of the competition form for stage 2. 19h30 - Publication of results and solutions of stage 2 and global.

* The Sunday schedule may have changes that will be notified on Saturday afternoon.

COMPETITION

The competition will consist of a Trail-O, in the TEMP-O mode, with two stages. Each stage will have 7 stations with 5 tasks each (35 questions in total).

Each task will be presented with:

- A photo of the ground indicating the position of the six beacons, taken from Google Street View.
- The plan of the area and with a circle indicating the control. The scale of each station will be advised before each one.
- Description of Control.
- An arrow indicating north.
- The answer options (A, B, C, D, E, F, Z). The Z option is used if none of the other options are correct. There is only one valid answer.

!NEW!

Since we consider that flexibility when conducting the competition can be interesting, we are going to carry out the test in stage 1 of keeping the form open for 11 hours, so that each participant chooses the time that most interests them to carry out the competition. In addition, this can avoid network overload at a specific time.

Obviously, this carries with it a couple of extra considerations:

- Each person receives a personal and non-transferable form (do not forward to other participants). Therefore, it is important to have previously registered.
- The form will be limited to a certain time. This total time will be send in the last email before the competition.

- Due to the new system implemented, there is a question on the form that will be automatically filled out and DO NOT TOUCH (see below). Otherwise, the result will not be considered.

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- The form will record time of entry and exit in hh:mm:ss format. The fractions of time, therefore, will be the difference in seconds.
- The form will have a countdowns clock. If you exceed the time, you can send your answers, but you will be disqualified.

On Saturday afternoon, the competition committee will evaluate the experience and decide, with prior notice to the competitors, the format for Sunday, that is, if it continues as STAGE 1 has been done or is done in a classical way, that is to say, I will have the form at a certain time and the time per hour of shipment is counted.

At the end of each stage, the test questionnaires will be published on the FUNDI-O website so that each person who wishes to do so will carry out the competition in a more relaxed format.

RESULTS

The results will be as follows:

- Classification by time spent solving 35 problems each day.
- Penalty for each failure of 30 fractions of time.
- Total sum of both stages according to the criteria indicated above.
